Assessment requirements:	Linear exams are taken at the end of A2. Paper 1: Introductory topics in psychology. Paper 2: Psychology in context. Paper 3: Issues and debates in psychology. Each written paper lasts 2 hours and makes up 33.3% of the total A2 marks. Each section includes multiple choice, short
	answer and extended writing. Each exam has 96 marks in total.
Scheme of work overview:	 Unit 1: Introductory topics in psychology, including social influence, memory, attachment, and psychopathology. Unit 2: Psychology in context, including approaches in psychology, biopsychology, and research methods. Unit 3: Issues and debates in psychology, including gender, stress, and aggression/ forensic psychology (TBD). The examination format is identical to that of Paper 1 and 2.
