## **CHANGE TO ADMISSIONS CRITERIA 2019-2020 – CONSULTATION**

Holmer Green Senior School propose to change their Admissions Criteria slightly to become as set out below (with the change emboldened):

Where eligible applications for admission exceed the number of places available, the following criteria will be applied in the order set out below to decide which student/s to admit:

1. Looked after children. A looked after child is a child who is either in the care of the local authority or being provided with accommodation by a local authority in the exercise of their social services functions, or previously looked after children who were looked after but ceased to be so because they were adopted (or became subject to a child arrangements order or special guardianship order.)
2. Students living in the catchment area of the school. Please see the Catchment Area Map on the following link:

3. Siblings of students in Years 7 to 10 who are on the roll of the school at the time allocations are made and who will be on the roll of the school at the time of the proposed admission.
4. Students who have exceptional medical or social needs which can only be met at this school supported by evidence as set out in the County Scheme. Once the rules have been applied, then any further places will be offered in distance order using the methodology set out in the County Scheme.
- 5. Children of parents where one or more parents works at the school at the time of application.**
6. Children who live outside the defined catchment area.
