Local Offer Description

This school supports students who have a Speech, Language and Communication Need (SLCN) and a 26 place ARP is provided for identified students. The SENCO works with Speech Therapists and Intervention Tutors to ensure successful outcomes for students with SCLN. Our SEN Department also caters for a variety of Specific Learning Difficulties (SpLD – Dyslexia, Dyscalculia, Dyspraxia, Dysgraphia). Some students may also have physical and/or sensory impairments.

At HGSS we believe that your child's learning needs will first be met through the high quality teaching delivered by his/her class teacher. Regular professional development ensures that staff at HGSS are fully aware of how to cater for a range of Special Educational Needs. The Learning Support Department and Special Learning Resources team are in regular communication with teaching staff to make sure that everyone is aware of what Special Educational needs there are within the school, and how to help support those needs in the classroom.
