



## Holmer Green Senior School 16 to 19 Study Programmes

We ensure all students in our 6<sup>th</sup> Form satisfactorily meet the 16 to 19 study programme requirements. Study programmes are individually tailored for students' needs, and can be a combination of academic or vocational qualifications. Study programmes are full time and provide sufficient planned hours. All students study typically three substantial qualifications, and where students enter the 6<sup>th</sup> Form without a GCSE '4' in English or mathematics they will study for a GCSE in that subject. Students take part in work experience in Year 12 that gives them the opportunity to develop their career choices. Students undertake a wide range of non-qualification activities, including the Duke of Edinburgh's Award, World Challenge and a wide variety of charity work that develops their skills, attitudes and confidence.

NB: Teaching at the end of Year 12 (ie, after the mock examinations) delivers the start of the A-Level specifications.
