

STUDENT BEHAVIOUR CODE OF CONDUCT RESIDENTIAL / DAY TRIPS

Holmer Green Senior School provides a number of educational opportunities through residential and day trips for all our students during their education. We would like our students to bear in mind a few rules which will ensure that these trips benefit all parties.

Whilst on a school trip, I will: -

- Remain courteous and considerate to my school friends, teachers and other adults
- Be aware of others' feelings
- Follow instructions from staff at all times
- Do my best to participate in the event so as to ensure that everyone benefits from the experience

I agree to the Behaviour Code of Conduct detailed below whilst participating in a school trip or event. I will not: -

- Take a mobile phone on the trip unless permission has been granted from the Headteacher
- Use, purchase or sell cigarettes or vapes etc.
- Use, purchase or sell drugs, or narcotic products
- Use, purchase or sell alcoholic drinks
- Carry out nuisance, intimidating, or disruptive behaviour.
- Engage or take part in any inappropriate behaviour of a sexual or non-sexual nature
- Engage in any form of self-harm activity or carry any blades, razors, scissors or other sharp implements
- Agree to allow staff to search all luggage prior to starting a trip and at any time during a trip and to the confiscation of any items deemed unsuitable by staff

All **parents** agree to cover any costs incurred if a student has to be withdrawn from a trip for breach of the above rules. If a student is sent home early the parent will arrange and pay for their safe transport home.
