Human Lifespan Development (1 hour) – Research and write definitions and two paragraphs for physical, intellectual, social and emotional development.

Research Piaget’s theory of cognitive development and type a page to summarise your findings.

Working in Health and Social Care (1 hour) – Research 5 job roles in health and social care settings, what responsibilities do they carry?

What is the Care Quality Commission (CQC)? Write 3 paragraphs to summarise your findings.

Meeting Individual Care and Support Needs (1 hour) - Define equality, diversity and discrimination.

Create a spider diagram of 10 skills and personal attributes you feel are required for developing relationships with individuals.

Research and summarise Argyle, Tuckman and Berne’s theories of communication – one paragraph for each theory.

Psychological Perspectives (1 hour) - Research and write a paragraph to summarise the following theories -

Pavlov’s conditioning theory

Bandura’s social learning theory

Freud’s psychodynamic theory

Gesell’s maturational theory

Further/extra research (2hours) - Health and Social Care in the Media
